NEW PATHWAY

"In Dec. 2016, the City Centre completed phase 1 of a new ten foot wide meandering bike path from Civic Center Dr. north to Corporate Dr. adjacent to the north bound Northwestern Highway Service Drive. In Spring 2017 the pathway will be completed with new landscaping, benches, and art installations," reported Terry Croad, Director of Planning.

LAWRENCE TECH COLLABORATORY

Established in 2013 by Lawrence Technological University in partnership with the City of Southfield, the Collaboratory is part of the Southfield SmartZone, now known as Southfield Centrepolis, one of 17 innovation centers in the Michigan SmartZone network.

The Collaboratory focuses on helping companies with product development, engineering, prototyping and manufacturing of physical products...such as medical, safety, consumer and industrial products.

"It has become a niche for us and is what Detroit and the Metro area are known for. We are filling the gap that is underserved in being able to help companies design and manufacture products," explains Mark Brucki, executive director of Corporate & Community Partnerships at Lawrence Tech.

"I can't underscore how fortunate we are to have the partnership of Southfield at the table. First and foremost, they are the reason we can do all of this," he says.

EVERCENTRE

The City of Southfield is looking for property developers

The goal of the "EverCentre" vision plan is to create a walkable pedestrian-friendly urban destination adjacent to the Southfield Municipal Campus that combines the aspirations of a high-profile business climate with a commitment to walkability, community and sense of place.

This plan provides the vision and redevelopment tools to assist the City in facilitating the development of a highly walkable and dynamic mixed-use environment while linking to the Evergreen Road corridor, Municipal Campus, Lawrence Technological University and existing business and residential developments in the City Centre district.

The vision plan was based upon recent market studies, which indicate that the site could potentially support: 184,000 sq. ft. of retail space, including restaurants and flex space; 250 units of residential (including multi-family rental and condos); a parking garage, boutique hotel & conference center and linear public park.
